Course Details

DATES: **Arrival:** 26 Sept 2018 or 27th Sept 2018 before 9h00am (the course starts on 27th Sept 9h00am). Arrival on 26th at an extra cost – see FEES.
Departure: 30 Sept 2018 (minimum four hours after the Final Match)
or 01 Oct 2018 at an extra cost – see FEES.

Financial Obligations

The costs of transportation (home to host nation and return), registration fees, accommodation and meals, and visa, are paid by the candidates or by their respective NPC or National Federation.

Course Fee: € 395 – **single room** per candidate to be paid to FFVolley (**Paid by 31 July**)
€ 325 – **shared room** per candidate to be paid to FFVolley (**Paid by 31 July**)
- Please note that accommodation in a shared room may not be possible depending on the number and gender of participants.
- There is the possibility of an extra night before or after the course for € 55 per night in a single room or €31 per night in a shared room (includes breakfast only)

Course Fee includes: Accommodation for **3 nights** and 7 meals + breakfasts between 27th and 30th of September, all local transport (except transfers – see below), course materials, and instruction by a World ParaVolley educator.

For transfers please consider:

- From Lille train station (« Flandres » or « Europe ») - duration 20 min: **€15** per person (two-way)
- From Lille « Lesquin » airport – duration 35 min: **€20** per person (two-way)
- From Bruxelles or Charleroy airports – duration 1h15: **€50** per person (two-way)

World ParaVolley Registration Fee: A non-refundable registration fee of **Euro 60** (including Bank Administration Fee of Euro 10) per candidate must be paid directly to World ParaVolley (This is **not** included in the above Course Fee).

Entry Requirements

Procedure: Registration should be made through the nation's World ParaVolley member organization, NPC, or National Volleyball Federation, using the official form.

Participants' Qualification:

- Ideally candidates should have prior knowledge of volleyball, though not necessarily Sitting Volleyball. Applications from FIVB qualified referees are particularly welcome.
- There is no age limit for this Level 1 (National/Regional) course, however candidates need to be aware that if they wish to progress to Level 3 (International Level) they must not have reached their 45th Birthday on the first day the International course commences.

Language of Instruction: English: Candidates must be able to converse in, and read and write English. This is compulsory.

Quota: - Each nation may normally register not more than 2 candidates. Extra candidates can be registered by agreement with the Referee Commission and World ParaVolley Sport Director.
- This clinic is planned for a maximum of 6 candidates.

COURSE OUTLINE

Level 1 Referee Course (National and Regional)

Registration Deadline: 31 July 2018

Referees are one cornerstone to the development of the sport and a key element of the foundations. Ideally candidates should have prior knowledge of volleyball, though not necessarily Sitting Volleyball. Applications from FIVB qualified referees are particularly welcome and should be encouraged. Because of the movement required by Sitting Volleyball referees the role is unfortunately not suited to those in wheelchairs or with considerable movement problems.

The course will include sessions on the following, but not necessarily in this sequence:

- Volleyball for athletes with physical impairment
- Expectations of the Referee
- Introduction on the Role of the Referee & the Referee Code of Conduct
- Referee Match and Event Preparation
- Detailed study of the current Rules of the Game
- Interpretation of the Rules of the Game
- Introduction to Practical Officiating
- Terminology
- Application of Official Hand Signals & Line Judge Signals
- Practice and Evaluation
- Explanation of the Score-sheet
- Score sheet Examination
- A Written Examination
- A Practical Examination

*Candidates will receive either a Level 1 Diploma or a Certificate of Attendance, depending on their performance.

All candidates must bring their own whistle.

Qualification Requirements

- Ideally candidates should have prior knowledge of volleyball, though not necessarily Sitting Volleyball. Applications from FIVB qualified referees are particularly welcome.
- There is no age limit for this Level 1 (National/Regional) course, however candidates need to be aware that if they wish to progress to Level 3 (International Level) they must not have reached their 45th Birthday on the first day the International course commences.
